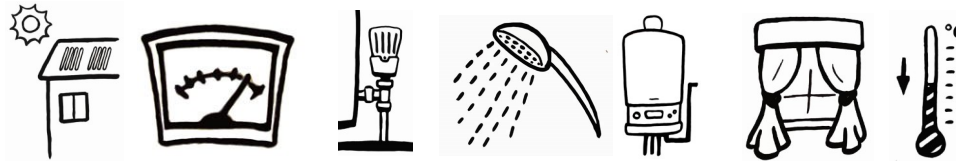
Do you want to adapt/retrofit your home and/or lifestyle to reduce your carbon footprint and become better able to cope with climate change?

- External wall insulation, some DIY internal insulation and underfloor insulation
- Triple glazing
- Solar PV (electricity)
- Wood boiler stove
- Water saving and rainwater collection
- Car-sharing, walking and cycling

1930s semi-detached house. 52 Heyworth Rd, Rowley Fields LE3 2DB

- External and internal solid wall insulation, also underfloor insulation
- Secondary, double, triple and cheap DIY glazing
- External blinds and other electricity-free cooling methods for heatwaves
- Rain water collection
- Cheap DIY energy saving: draught stripping, pillow stuffing, letterboxes, chinking
- Solar PV (electricity)
- Low carbon foods and living without a fridge
- Choosing to live at low temperatures

1910 semi-detached house 39 Western Park Rd LE3 6HQ

- External wall insulation, underfloor insulation, between rafter insulation
- MVHR (mechanical ventilation and heat recovery system)
- High grade double glazing
- Air source heat pump with underfloor heating downstairs and radiators upstairs
- AAA appliances
- Bringing children up vegan
- Composting and food growing
